Trove Strategic Advisory Committee



Key messages

In November 2019, Trove Partners elected six representatives to the Trove Strategic Advisory Committee (TSAC) from across the Partner community. Suzie Gately (City of Newcastle) and Anna Raunik (State Library of Queensland) have now joined the Committee as NLA appointed members.

At the inaugural meeting, the Committee discussed the roles, responsibilities and functioning of the Committee. A number of more frequent and shorter meetings are scheduled in the next couple of months to replace the face-to-face format not possible due to COVID-19.

COVID-19 and Partner engagement

Most Trove Collaborative Services (TCS) are internet-based, so can be accessed remotely. There have been a number of changes to the way services are delivered and communicated as a result of COVID-19, including:

- increased communication and frequency of online webinars;
- increased data improvement projects possible with the slowdown in database acitivity;
- providing support exclusively via online enquiry forms and email (i.e. no phone service).

Trove redesign launch plan

Redesigned Trove will be launched on 26 June and the Committee considered the launch plan.

Additional features specifically directed at the Partner community include curated Collection Features to appear on Trove, a Partner Learning Hub and a Partner dashboard with collection analysis insights.

In preparation for launch, TCS has developed the 'Take 20 with Trove' webinar series. These short 20 minute webinars highlight features in the new interface and provide Partners the opportunity to ask questions about redesigned Trove.
