Extending the membership base

Results of a survey distributed to non-members across the GLAM sector indicated a general interest in promoting access to collections and a desire to digitise collections but also identified low levels of technical capacity and unpredictable funding as barriers to achieving this.

Collaboration with Partners might be one way to encourage organisations to become members and contribute their unique content to Trove.

A survey will be distributed to Partners in March, and focus groups held in May.
